This ranges from VIP corporate hospitality ticketing through to general attendance at sporting, cultural and lifestyle events across Queensland. Working with the Destination Partnerships Leader, who will provide strategic direction for the program, the Destination Partnerships Specialist will engage with a broad range of internal and external stakeholders.
